"I am honored to serve in this new capacity as ASA Chairman, and look forward to the opportunity to advocate on behalf of our members, our clients, and the millions of people we place and employ every day," said Livonius, a staffing veteran with more than 20 years in the industry.

He served as Chief Operating Officer for publicly-held Spherion Corp. (formerly Interim Services), responsible for \$3.5 billion in revenues and 1,200 offices in the U.S., Europe and Asia. Livonius also held the position of Executive Vice President of Healthcare Operations, and was responsible for expanding the healthcare division to more than \$700 million in revenues in healthcare staffing and home care services. He holds bachelor's degrees in both marketing and engineering from the University of Colorado.
